



## ACCOMPLISHMENTS in 2018

Activists: over 25 members (primary club); Club raised over \$13K  
at least 2350 hours campaigning

- Michael Eggman, CD10 primary: 2 members, 10 hrs

- T.J.Cox, CD21 10 members, 325 hours, mostly walking; one member 230 hrs, including organizing trips
- Andrew Janz, CD 22, Sep 23 raised \$3K; 5 members, 122 hrs
- Palo Alto City Council: 1 member 40 hrs organizing C. Wolbach events; 2 members 9 hrs for endorsed candidates

### California Clean Money Campaign 2018 Wins: AB 2188, Social Media DISCLOSE Act; AB 2155, AB 249 Cleanup; AB2707, Electeds lookup website; SB822, CA net neutrality

At least 10 members, about 700hrs; 1 member is northern California volunteer coordinator (at least 500 hrs)

- Lobbying in Sacramento: 7 hearings, 5 members (including coordinator), total 15 trips
- Work parties: mailings, data entry and other support, 10 members, 97 hrs incl. at least 25 for April 7 northern CA grassroots summit

### Other club goals

- Single Payer/Medicare for all: SB562 not being voted on this year
- Environment: SB 100, Greenhouse Gases (which our club endorsed) passed August, club statement in support; at least 2 members testified at Santa Clara Valley Water Board against Delta tunnels in May; club letter in opposition; letter to state water board to increase water flow from San Joaquin River tributaries for environmental reasons, July; club sign-on to SB100, August

**Voter registration:** 1 member organizer 42 hrs; 8 more members total 79 hrs; club total 121 hrs

### Democratic Party participation

- Democratic Volunteer Center, north county: 7 members, 696 hrs, one member ~500 hrs
- County: annual dinner planning, full-page ad, 2 tables; presence at monthly meetings, including club report; recruiting table at Democratic Party Unity/all-clubs picnic; 6 members attended, 2 new members  
1 member is vice chair of the Santa Clara County Democratic Party
- State party: 6 members (plus 3 for whom we're not primary club, incl. e-board rep) attended annual convention

### Club events

- Annual picnic & election of officers June 30; 18 electeds or their representatives attended
- Club fundraiser: Don Mayall memorial fund, ongoing: raised \$450, adding to 2017's \$850 for \$1300 total
- Monthly meetings, second Monday: CD10 candidates; Delaine Easton, gub.candidate; Citizens Climate Lobby; Climate Hawks; our biennial and very informative ballot initiative review; Assemblymember Marc Berman; public banking presentation; Steve Chessin re ranked choice voting, Otto Lee DNC report; pre-election action meeting (phoning, postcards, texting); election wrapup with Melinda Jackson & Otto Lee; annual potluck & 2019 goal brainstorming
- "Paid plus" members: 32 by end of year
